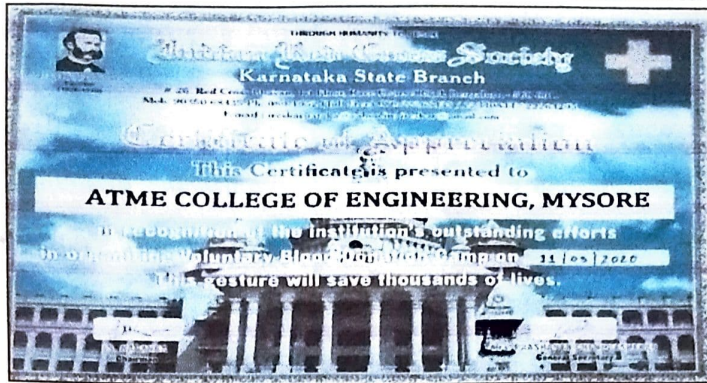
### Blood Donation, Eye and Dental Check-up Camp at ATMECE, Mysuru

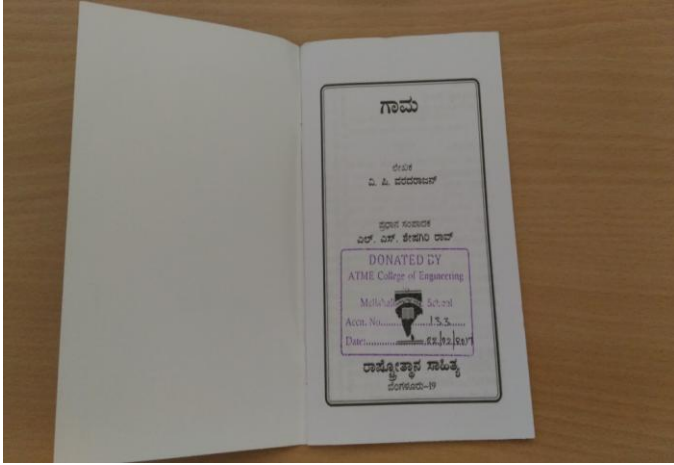


- Class rooms, Head master room, Library, Kitchen Boards are also ready to be installed.

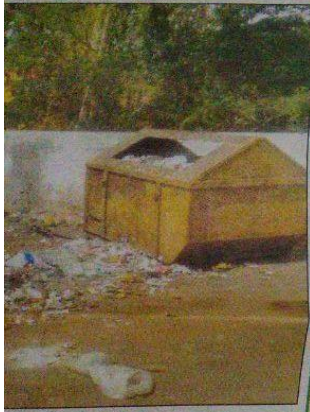

People were also educated on how stagnant water may result in harmful diseases like dengue, malaria and to segregate dry and wet waste.

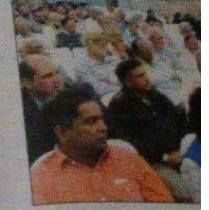
People aired their grievances caused due to the inefficiency of local authority in maintaining the village clean and they also
